

# FIGHT COLON CANCER: SHARE YOUR STORY

A digital storytelling workshop.

- ❖ Share how colorectal cancer has impacted you or someone you know.
- ❖ Explore how your story can lead to learning, action and positive change.
- ❖ Make your own digital story!

In this workshop you will create a digital story about how colon cancer has impacted you or someone you know. We will help you design and produce a 3-5 minute digital story with voice, images, video and music. You will be required to attend all three days of the workshop (one Saturday and the following Saturday/Sunday) and to authorize for your story to be used as an educational tool. Your story—along with others—will be posted on the website for the California Dialogue on Cancer (CDOC) and California Colorectal Cancer Coalition (C4) to be used by health educators, medical providers, and colorectal cancer advocates. These stories will help to build a survivor network and raise awareness about how colon cancer is preventable, treatable, and beatable!

Whether you are a patient, survivor, caregiver, medical provider, or have lost someone you loved—let your experience be a resource for others in your community and beyond.
